Fees are charged on a sliding scale from \$90 - 125

Letters and reports needed: \$150.00

Court appearances: \$125/hr plus mileage if outside of Reno County

Addiction evaluation: \$125.00

Forms

At the time of your first visit, you will be asked to complete some routine forms.

Note:

The number of visits recommended will vary according to the existing problem and the participation of the client.

Confidentiality

All information that is shared between therapist and client is held within strict confidentiality as outlined by the American Association of Marriage and Family Therapy's Code of Ethics and the Behavioral Science Review Board of the State of Kansas. Only information that is authorized by release of the client will be shared.

Kansas law requires that the rights of confidentiality do not apply under the following conditions: child abuse, intent to harm self or others and information subpoenaed by a court order.

Your Rights

You have the right to participate in directing the course of your own therapy. You may terminate your therapy at any given time. At your request, you may be referred to another therapist of your choice. You also have the right to be informed of fees and available methods of payment.
